

Sigma Nu Educational Foundation Application for Scholarship Keys

Per The Law (Article Seven, Section 9.1, Scholarship Honor Key),

"A Collegiate Chapter, through itself or its Alumni, may provide annually a gold Honor Key to the upperclassman who attains the highest scholarship average for the year; and a silver Honor Key to the freshman who attains the highest scholarship average for the year."

Scholarship keys may be awarded once annually based on achieved grade point average for a single term (i.e., not cumulative average). Each year, the Brother (Gold Key) and Candidate (Silver Key) with the highest single-term GPA (fall, winter, or spring) from the previous academic year are eligible to be recognized with a scholarship key dangle that may be worn with their badge.

The annual deadline to request scholarship keys is October 15.

Scholarship keys are free to order and will be engraved with the recipient's personal information. Orders can be made by submitting a scan of this completed and signed form to <u>headquarters@sigmanu.org</u>. Orders will be accepted one per chapter/colony per year for the previous academic year. In the case of a tie in highest GPA from the year (based on a single academic term – fall, winter, or spring), more than one key of each type may be granted. In this case, please complete an additional form and indicate such in your submission.
